### **Application Format:**

- Applications should include a brief description of the topic (approximately two to three sentences), an abstract with a **maximum of 400 words** prepared for a blind selection process, and a few keywords related to the presentation. (To ensure anonymity in the selection process, please do not include any names on the document!)
- Each participant will have **40 minutes for their presentation**, divided into 25 minutes for the presentation and 15 minutes for subsequent Q&A.
- Abstracts and presentations should be written in either German or English.
- The submission deadline is March 31, 2025.
